David N. Glaser, M.D. is Board Certified in Forensic Psychiatry, as well as Board Certified in Psychiatry and Neurology. He is on the Faculty of the UCLA Forensic Psychiatry Fellowship program and the Advisory Board of the American College of Forensic Psychiatry. Dr. Glaser is also an Expert Reviewer for the Medical Board of California. Over the past 25 years, Dr. Glaser has performed thousands of Forensic Psychiatric Evaluations in the civil, criminal, disability and workers' compensation arenas. Dr. Glaser has been appointed by judges in circumstances of disputed testimony and frequently performs agreed medical evaluations upon request of both sides. He has been deposed hundreds of times, and his trial testimony is extensive, both in State and Federal courts. The breakdown of referrals to Dr. Glaser is approximately 50% plaintiff and 50% defense. Areas of his specialization include employment matters (wrongful termination, discrimination, and sexual harassment), emotional and physical injuries, brain injury, pain-related syndromes, catastrophic trauma, psychopharmacology, competency, boundary violations, Americans with Disabilities Act matters, psychiatric malpractice, Medical Board cases, and childhood trauma. Dr. Glaser has particular expertise in the diagnosis and treatment of Major Depressive Disorder, as well as Posttraumatic Stress Disorder.

David B. Freeman, Ph.D., is a Forensic Psychologist and Board Certified, UCLA trained Neuropsychologist. Dr. Freeman has conducted well over 1000 medical-legal evaluations and is available to perform agreed medical evaluations in the workers' compensation arena. Dr. Freeman serves as an IME (Independent Medical Examiner) in the field of civil litigation.
