She has worked at Project Renewal, Gracie Square Hospital and Manhattan Psychiatric Center where she has served on both the Forensic committee and Ethics committee.

EXPERT WITNESS EXPERIENCE

- Appeared in Court regularly as an Expert Witness while working in the State Hospital System and Forensic State Psychiatric Unit at Manhattan Psychiatric Center over 3.5 years.
- Interpreting 730 final evaluations, treating psychiatric symptoms whilst evaluating for fitness to stand trial.
- Provided recommendations as an Expert Witness based on clinical need, safety to patient and community, and current Mental Hygiene Law.
- Completing Violence Risk Evaluations in relation to safety to discharge to the community.
- Testified in Court as an Expert Witness with regards to a patient's current violence risk, based on current and retrospective data.
- Completing thorough psychiatric evaluations whilst evaluating diagnostic criteria in relation to DSM IV and DSM V.
- Evaluating capacity to sign for consent and to refuse medical procedures including amputations and other Emergency Medical Procedures.
- Prepared Court documents for application for treatment over objection including inpatient hospitalization, medication over objection, and electroconvulsive therapy over objection.
- Testified in Court, reported events and diagnosis, psychiatric history and response to previous treatments as per patient chart and personal observation.

- Testified in court as an Expert Witness with regards to risk to the patient and community, should a patient be discharged from the state or forensic system without adequate outpatient provisions.

- Completed suicide evaluations using the Columbia Suicide Scale, and determining suicide risk.
