- 2018: Awarded Virginia Lynch Pioneer Award by International Association of Forensic Nursing. Highest award bestowed by the organization to recognize significant contributions to the field of Forensic Nursing.
- 2015: Recognized as Naval Medical Center Portsmouth “Master Clinician”; the 1st Forensic Nurse in the Department of Defense to be given this designation.
- 2015: Selected as Civilian of the Quarter, Category II, Clinical, for Naval Medical Center Portsmouth (citation available on request).
- 2014: Personally requested by Graduate School of Nursing, Uniformed Services University of Health Sciences, to create lectures for military graduate nursing students; additionally, collaborating with renowned author and forensic expert, Dr. Ann W. Burgess, to utilize these lectures for her nursing classes at Boston University. This curriculum was presented by USUHS faculty at the NATO Human Factors & Medicine Panel Symposium in Paris, France in October 13th, 2015
- 2013: *In Oct 2013, one of only 32 Advanced Forensic Nurses – Board Certified nurses credentialed world-wide by ANCC. Currently, there are 76 AFN-BCs, and no more will be added to the roster, making this a highly prestigious credential.
- 2011: Appointed as Forensic Healthcare Coordinator, Naval Medical Center Portsmouth, by Rear Admiral Alton Stocks. This marks the first military facility in the U.S. Navy with a full time Forensic Nurse Examiner to oversee the program.
- 2010: Regarded by Virginia Lynch, pioneer of the specialty of Forensic Nursing, as one of three U.S. Navy Nurses responsible for promoting the specialty within the Department of Defense and Veterans’ Affairs.
